

# How to use the wiring diagrams

Look up the relevant electrical function in the index.  
 Let us say you want to look at the central locking system.  
 According to the index, the central locking system is found  
 on page 146.

Here is a schematic presentation of how the components  
 are connected to each other and their internal  
 appearance.


Each component has a component designation.  
 At the end of the manual there is a component  
 list where you can see what each component  
 is called.

Wire colours are indicated with letters of the alphabet:


SB = Black	BN = Brown	GN = Green
GR = Grey	Y = Yellow	OR = Orange
W = White	P = Pink	VO = Purple
R = Red	BL = Blue.	

BL-R is thus = Blue-red.

Code to colours in the wiring diagram

-  = no voltage
-  = system voltage
-  = voltage lower than system voltage
-  = ground connection
-  = intertwined wires
-  = screened wire

## Central locking
